

Tryout Requirements

REQUIRED-BEFORE THE TRYOUT!!!

Go online (<http://www.iavbreg.org/>) and complete the membership application process, either as a new member or renewing member.

1. Choose 'TRYOUT MEMBERSHIP' / RENEW MEMBERSHIP.
2. Indicate 'UNDECIDED' under Club Affiliation. When you are selected and accept an invitation to a club, you may then go back and change to the club you are joining.
3. Payment can be done online by credit card (MasterCard or Visa) or send a check to the Region Office.

4. When you finish the Registration process, print the confirmation page and take a copy to all tryouts and give to the club at sign in. You must also print and fill out the Medical History Form (part of online registration process) and take a copy with you to all tryouts.

5. Once the payment has been received either online or in the Region Office, the player will become a member with a current status.

Johnston Spiketacular

Each year JVBC hosts a tournament, the Johnston Spiketacular. This tournament is a fundraiser for JVBC as well as an opportunity for the teams to play "at home". We will have two 2017 dates, in January and March.

Johnston VBC

JVBC was established in 2000 as a feeder program to the Johnston Community Schools. Since that time, JVBC has strived to become a competitive club in the state. All teams are formed using competitive tryouts each fall.

JVBC attempts to field two teams at each age group. If there is coach availability, a National team and a Regional team will be formed.

National level teams compete in at least one National Qualifier tournament, where they compete against teams from across the country. The remainder of their tournaments are within Iowa or surrounding states.

Regional teams typically compete in tournaments within Iowa. Both teams also play in the Regional tournament at the end of the USA season.

All tournaments are typically one or two days long and are held on either Saturdays or Sundays. National Qualifiers are usually three days.

Season Information

The USA season starts with practices in December (twice a week), and tournaments run January through April. Tournaments are held across the United States, however JVBC generally attends a majority of tournaments within Iowa and a few tournaments in surrounding states. Each head coach will decide which tournaments they will attend depending upon schedule conflicts. Tournaments fill up quickly, so a tentative schedule must be created in early December.

Costs: National Teams: \$900*

Regional Teams: \$525

Regional 12U: \$300 (metro league only)

Boys: \$700

Fees cover two uniform jerseys, shorts, a referee and score clinic, tournament entry fees, and coaching fees. Players can purchase warm-ups at an additional cost. All costs listed above are for the regular USA season. Additional fees will be added if a team qualifies for Nationals.

*Payments for National teams can be in one payment or two payments of \$450.00.

Dates/Ages/Times:

October 22nd and 29th: 12U-14U players/boys

November 5th and 12th: 15U-18U players/boys

All tryouts are from 1:00-3:00 pm.

Location: Johnston HS gyms.

Cost: \$25/player (online) or \$35 at the door— includes one or more tryouts.

2016-2017 Age Definitions:

18 and Under Division:

Players who were born on or after September 1, 1998 or players who were born on or after September 1, 1997 and a high school student in the twelfth (12th) grade or below during some part of the current academic year .

17 and Under Division:

Players who were born on or after September 1, 1999

16 and Under Division:

Players who were born on or after September 1, 2000

15 and Under Division:

Players who were born on or after September 1, 2001

14 and Under Division:

Players who were born on or after September 1, 2002

13 and Under Division:

Players who were born on or after September 1, 2003

12 and Under Division:

Players who were born on or after September 1, 2004
